**BUILDING PROGRAM**

The new facility will consist of one (1) single building that accommodates the paramedic and fire support services. The Program Requirements provided at the beginning of the Pre-Design Stage indicate a total gross floor area of 12,900 sq. ft. that is based on the following allocation:

- a) Halton Region Paramedic Services Station 17: 4,400 sq. ft.
- b) Milton Fire Station No. 5: 8,500 sq. ft.

The Program Requirements indicate the proposed building will accommodate the administrative and emergency vehicle storage functions of the paramedic and fire support services. The paramedic services portion of the building will provide accommodation for staff, offices/work rooms, washrooms and showers, storage rooms and service rooms as well as an apparatus bay for three (3) emergency vehicles. The fire services portion of the building will also provide accommodation for staff, office spaces, washrooms and showers, storage rooms and service rooms, a training room, a fitness room, a hose tower, as well as an apparatus bay for three (3) fire trucks.

**Staffing**

Staffing of the respective services is as follows:

- a) Halton Region Paramedic Services Station 17: 21 full time staff (3 shifts at 6 staff/shift and 3 students).
  - Maximum occupancy at a time: 3x2+2 (when two shift staff overlap) totaling 8.
- b) Milton Fire Station No. 5: 20 full time staff (4 shifts at 5 staff per shift).
